| 3 | Pictures: Cut out pictures from a magazine, newspaper, or print pictures from the computer to show each word and write the word beside it. |
| 4 | Sensational sentences: Choose 5 words and write 5 sensational sentences (5 |
| 5 | Magazine or Newspaper words: Cut all words out of a magazine or newspaper and paste to one page |
| 6 | ABC order: Put words in alphabetical order |
| 7 | Vowels \& Consonants: Write each word with all vowels written in red and consonants written in blue |
| 8 | $\frac{\text { Flashcards: }}{\text { to turn in) }}$ Make flashcards for each word and study (place in a Ziplock bag |
| 9 | Practice Test: Have an adult give you a practice test, an adult checks it, and an adult signs the practice test. |
| 10 | Reverse ABC order: Put all words in REVERSE (backwards) alphabetical order |
| 11 | Spelling City: Practice words on www.spellingcity.com, then take a practice test, and PRINT the report to turn in. |
| 12 | Consonant circles - Write your words in pencil, then circle the consonants with a pen, colored pencil, or crayon. |
| 13 | Rainbow writing - Write all words 2 times so that every letter of each word should be written in a different color crayon, marker, or color pencil. |
| 14 | Pyramid Writing - Write the first letter of your word, then on the next line write the first two letters of your word. Continue doing this until you have the word spelled Example: c <br> ca cat |
| 15 | Computer writing - Type your words on the computer, print-out, and bring to |
| 16 | Backward writing - First, write your spelling word. Then, write it backwards. |
| 17 | Code writing - Write your spelling words using a code. <br> (Example: $1=\mathrm{a}, 2=\mathrm{b}, 3=\mathrm{c}, 4=\mathrm{d}, 5=\mathrm{e}$ bed $=2,5,4$ ) |
| 18 | Tongue twisters - Choose five of your spelling words and write a tongue twister sentence using each of them in a sentence. <br> (All words will start with the same letter. Example: Pink pigs play the piano.) Underline the spelling word. |
| 19 | Money Spelling - Write your spelling words and then figure out how much each spelling word is worth. <br> (Example: play $=.15+.50+.05+.50=\$ 1.20)$ |

| 20 | Rice/Pasta Words - Use rice or pasta to make your words. |

| 22 | Word Sort - Sort your words according to some common attribute - syllables, vowels, consonants, blends, suffixes/endings, prefixes, rhyme, what the word starts with etc. |
| 23 | Opposite Handed - Write your spelling words using your non-writing hand! Then with your writing hand. |
| 24 | Fancy Letters - Write your words using bubble letters, dotted letters, curly $q$ letters, or some other fancy form of writing. |
| 25 | Telephone Spelling - Using a cell phone keypad or land line phone key pad to spell your words. Write down each spelling word's phone number and write the word beside it! |
| 26 | Shape Words - Get creative. Write your words in the shape of something - make a rainbow, animal, person, or flower out of your spelling words. |
| 27 | Upper \& Lower Case - Write your words in both upper and lower case letters or just mix upper and lower case letters (e.g., chair = Chair CHAIR chair). |
| 28 | Connect the dots - Write your spelling words using dots and connect the dots to reveal your letters! |
| 29 | Riddle Words - Write a riddle for each of your spelling words. Don't forget to add the answer! |
| 30 | How Much is it Worth? - Write your spelling words and use the letters to add up how much each word is worth. <br> Number Values: $1=\mathrm{a}, 2=\mathrm{b}, 3=\mathrm{c}, 4=\mathrm{d}, 5=\mathrm{e}$ ETC. <br> (Example: bed $=2+5+4=11$ pts $(\cdot)$ ) |
